We use them every day. Braided ribbons, like ropes or shoelaces or the string of your hoodie, are the most ordinary objects. However, they have multiple associations, meanings, and functions. These objects collect historical, cultural, technical, social and systemic layers that make braided ribbon the inspiration for our Fiber Fever Summercamp 2023.

15 participants with different backgrounds will focus on engineering, techniques, patterns, colours, movement/ meaning and circular materials. They work in mixed groups on the multiple aspects of the braiding as elements of one collective outcome in the end.
